WHAT WE DO?

- 1. Women received health education and famine hygiene products and we provide them primary health care and do HIV AIDs program and STDs; we do fieldwork to experiment and we do medical camping
- 2. Women received traumainformed education and learn about their legal rights also, we do rescue, sex trafficking
- 3. Women receongoing lived businesses, grant accountability mentorship, and education and legal protection: vocational training and job placement.
- 4 To conduct various programs for the upliftment of exploited, oppressed, disadvantaged, Dalits, helpless, unskilled, discriminated women living in rural remote regions of the country and disadvantaged women and children by all means who have been displaced by conflicts and deteriorating country conditions in close coordination with the agencies under the prevailing laws along with the directives and policies of Nepal government so that these women can get the same space that the other general civilians enjoy.
- 5. To motivate the exploited, oppressed, disadvantaged, Dalit, helpless, unskilled, discriminated women living in a rural remote area to gather the local herbs and engage in agriculture, livestock and fruits production along with the operation of small and cottage industries in local level, to promote the production and skills, to trade their products in national and international markets and to develop human resources by provisioning skill-oriented training through this company.
- 6. To conduct programs related to reproductive health for exploited, oppressed, disadvantaged, Dalit, helpless, unskilled, and discriminated women living in rural remote areas and to conduct nutrition programs related to the children relying on them.
- 7. To raise awareness regarding women's health for the women generally living in a remote area with pain and work in women health sector and produce and sell the materials related to this sector in order to improve their health.
- 8. To advocate nationally and internationally for the discriminated women living in rural areas and to run the program for their shelter,

food, and education and put optimum efforts to turn them into efficient and skilled human resources in social, cultural, and

9. To run awareness-related seminars, workshops, and publications using digital mediums and to administer required consultancy services to exploited and oppressed women for their overall development.

We tell them about how to use this sanitary kits and how to be clean and be far from disease. We provide them an information about necessity things to do in period like do exercise and eat hot things etc.

Altogether, the local government of that areas were so cheer to be part of that program and the program about health and hygiene was so impactful for everybody. They were not satisfied by themselves because they want to send this good message to every one who are missing there. The local government are requesting us to give same knowledge to others areas also and asked to bring more.

We went chepang area and we distribute 470 sanitary kits there. And we encourage them to be clean and neat and use pad properly as we did same to Nepalgunj and Kailali.

Story of Parvati Lamichhane

I Parvati lamichhane and I belong from Brahmin family which means high caste family and I'm from hindu religion. Me and my whole family are educated and well developed family and my dad is business man. I want to share my own experiences on period. When I started period, my family never told me to do anything till 13 days because my family is so religious to god and they have different cultures. I felt like discrimination when I started to bleed and I come to know how poor people will feel when they were discriminated and untouchable from rich background people or high caste people. After that I love and care Dalit people because they are the one who used to get discriminated and feel it's as difficult. Now I'm 47 years

old and I have 4 daughter who follow traditional rituals and culture about period because what I learned I taught them now I'm not going to follow this culture for my daughter anymore. In their period I love them more and give extra care than as usual. And I commit myself that I will eradicate this rituals and break this culture from our society.

To sum up, thank you so much for your hard work on this and I couldn't have done or learn or follow and know that much information without you. It will be such a blessing if you organize more program about health and hygiene in every areas of world. Much appreciated.

Firstly, Being in period is cross for them and from childhood our society teach us that if we show our face towards our father. brothers and any man will going to died was fear for us. So we never went schools and outside of house when we will be in period even though if we bleed more, have dizziness or get more pain nobody come to help because it was our culture and also Nobody help to go hospital due to their thought that they will be uncleaned and will get sin. Our society never give permission to went in rivers for washing clothes or for bath, people used to told us that if we went then we will get punished from god so we never allow to went

outside our home and for bath. Still, it is there.

I am very glad that HER company gives new hope for us and HER teach us that throwing blood is gift of god and it is very important to be clean in period time. We should not hide our period because it is normal and natural cycle and importantly, it is very necessary to told every people that having menstruation cycle is gift of god for being able to give birth.

Because of their mother period, they were born is right example to give awareness program to everybody who think it is bad and sin. Finally, we know our dignity and glad to get knowledge about personal hygiene.

Not only 500 sisters, There are many more sister who are still waiting to know good news about health and hygiene.

Province No.: 7 District: Kailali & Muda

Kailali and Muda are badi village and 85% of women are involved in prostitution at the age of 9 because, lack of education and access to the outer world, badi girls grow of learning that prostitution is actually way of life for them. They never knew anything about period and what is it. They never left work when they are on period. Now, Women who will not be involved in prostitution are as labour in period and stopped to go for work for certain time.

So, We feel so happy to see and meet with people of Kailali again. It was our 2nd time visiting in Kailali for awareness program. In 2021, we were triumph to enlighten their village and besides we bestowed the pilot program but we were not able to distribute enough sanitary pad to everybody. We HER feel exhilarated to serve 250 sanitary pad in that areas and we help them by teaching how to be spotless in period time and also we were able to apprise them about its cause, effect and also its cure. We taught them to feel free and open up to talk about period. We see in their eyes that willingness and interest to learn. They are very eager to know more about period.

Story of Laxmi Badi

I am puja badi and I am from Badi community. I want to share my story here. I started to selling myself at the age of 13, I was raped by multiple boy even though my period wasn't started. For the first time, I was bleed so much and I thought it was because I slept with many boys but after 3 month, I got pain at lower belly, bleeding more and feelings of hungriness. Now I am 22 years old, I even don't the fixed date when my period was started and still unknown about I was on period or not.

When program goes on then only I knew I wasn't period on my first raped and my 2nd time bleeding was



menstruation cycle. From the age of 13 to 22,I never stopped to get prostitution in my period. I even don't know about pad which is used while we will be in period and we should be clean. I am thankfull to HER for their imagine program which give us new hope to live and for very useful knowledge about the period. For the first time, I spoke up myself and told my parents about the period without feeling hesitation and shy. Now I will care myself and not work when I will be on my period and also I will told my teammates and friend about period cure. I am greatful to HER because they taught us to love ourself first and specially take care of health in period. In my period, I used to eat dark chocolates and drink hot water. . Lastly, I feel like as normal girl and get the chance to share my story. Thank you and hope to see u again with new ideas and programs.


